SPECIAL WORKSHOP MEETING of the PARK COMMISSION

Thursday, May 3, 2007

The Special Workshop Meeting began at 5:30 pm at the Park House, 329 Third Avenue, Fontana, Wisconsin.

General Business

Walking Tour of Pioneer Park, Park House, Little Foot Playground, Reid Park, Triangle Park and Fontana Beach

The new planting bed next to the launch needs attention. In Pioneer Park, the Park Commission members noted the following areas of concern: the base of the water fountain needs to be repaired; garlic mustard plants must be pulled; the foundation and wall needs to be repaired and replacement was recommended as soon as possible; it must be determined if the "Jean Harvey tree" is alive; and weeds need to be pulled, plants need to be pruned, and areas need to be mulched. In Reid Park, the following areas of concern were noted: the grassy area north of the gazebo needs to be reseeded; the gazebo needs to be replaced, the foundation seem okay, and some wood is rotten; additional mulch is needed between maple trees; the removal of one of both of the pine and spruce tree behind the Reid Park sign on the curve needs to be considered; and weeds need to be pulled, plants need to be pruned, and areas need to be mulched. The area along Lake Street at the lakefront marina building needs attention. In Triangle Park – Fontana Weeps, the following areas of concern were noted: weeds need to be pulled, plants need to be pruned, and areas need to be mulched. In the beach area, the following areas of concern were noted: the gardens need to be mulched; and grass seed needs to be planted on the slope to the north of the beach house, mesh may be needed to hold grass seed on the slope, or sod slope. In Little Foot Playground, the following areas of concern were noted: the lighthouse needs to be repainted; replacement/repair of some play equipment should be considered; weeping crab apple trees need to be pruned and staked; weeds need to be pulled, plants need to be pruned, and areas need to be mulched; and some dead arborvitae has to be removed and replaced.

The workshop meeting was adjourned at 6:30 pm.
