**Approval of Minutes for Meeting September 18, 2017**

Corso/Frost 2<sup>nd</sup> made a MOTION to approve the minutes from September 18, 2017 as presented, and the MOTION carried without negative vote.

**Fire/Rescue Department**

**Monthly Report**

Chief Nitsch presented the monthly report. Chief Nitsch mentioned that Scott Peterson did a great job on writing a grant through the DNR in which the Fire Department was able to get a 50% match which resulted in \$11,000 in new equipment for the department. Chief Nitsch also pointed out that although a new ambulance is not in the budget for 2018, the current one is in need of some mechanical repairs.

**Police Department**

**Monthly Report**

Chief Cates presented his monthly administrative report.

**Mohr Road Parking**

Chief Cates said that it had always been no parking along the east side of Mohr Road and parking was allowed on the west side of the road. After the road had been recently repaved, they went to repost the signs according to the ordinance and found the ordinance to state no parking on the west side of the Mohr Road also. Many residents were unhappy about this and Chief Cates recommended amending the ordinance to read no parking along the east side only. Parking would be allowed along the west side.

Moravecek/Corso 2<sup>nd</sup> made a MOTION to recommend Village Board approval of the request to amend Sec. 74-281(a)-Specific Areas, as presented, to be no parking at any time on the east side of Mohr Road east of Club Unique from South Shore Drive to Geneva Lake.

**Abbey Springs Loud Noise**

Chief Cates said that there has been no progress on this issue since it is now the off season. He still plans on meeting with Lance Cotton from Abbey Springs to discuss the noise complaints to see if a resolution can be met.

### **Lakefront Resident Only Parking Area**

Designating some parking stalls in Lot 2 for resident only parking was discussed at the September meeting. Chief Cates stated that if 20 stalls were used in Lot 2 for this, there would be approximately \$10,000 lost from parking revenue. Chief Cates also believes that this would be opening the door to more parking problems in the Village. It was decided that no action would be taken at this time.

### **2018 Antique Boat Show Police Assistance for Fontana Blvd. Harbor Crosswalk**

Chief Cates stated that the police donate their time during the boat show to assist pedestrians crossing Fontana Blvd and also close one block of Reid St to help with traffic. This service will continue to be provided by the Police Department.
