Renewal/Extension of Paratech contract

Chief Nitsch stated the Paratech contract for the dayshift has been included in the 2017 budget. Nightshift coverage was eliminated from the 2017 proposed budget at the finance committee budget workshops, however, there is a new proposal to extend the 24-hour Paratech coverage until after a referendum can be placed on the Spring Election ballot. If the referendum passes it will allow for a special assessment on the tax bill to cover EMS services.

Allen/Moravecek 2nd made a MOTION to recommend Village Board approval of the Paratech night shift contract until April 30, 2017, and the MOTION carried without negative vote.
