Closed Session Business

Commissioner Henning/Commissioner Eshoo 2nd made a MOTION to promote Sergeant Jeffery Cates to Chief of Police effective January 1, 2017 per Wisconsin State Statute 62.13(3); salary benefits and probationary period if deemed applicable, to be determined by Village of Fontana Human Resource Committee/Village of Fontana Board of Trustees. The MOTION carried without negative vote.

Commissioner Henning/Commissioner Hicks 2nd made a MOTION to recommend Village Board approval to amend PFC Regulation 6.02 – Residency, to reflect "Residency" as it relates specifically to the Chief of Police, to be defined as a 20-mile radius from Village Hall, or a reasonable distance as determined by the Village of Fontana Board of Trustees. The PFC finds the current requirement to be burdensome, potentially discriminatory and operationally geographically unnecessary. The MOTION carried without negative vote.
